Dropzone Rules

Landing Area/Pattern

- Minimum activation altitude is 3000'.
- Jumpers must land either East or West, unless otherwise noted by the Meet Director.
- Jumpers must fly a left hand pattern when landing toward the West and a right hand pattern when landing to the East.
- No sashaying in the pattern.
- No spirals below 1000 feet.



- Jumpers must have a minimum of 500 jumps to land in “Area 1”
- Jumpers with less than 500 jumps must land in “Area 2”



Gear Storage

Gear Racks are for day use only. Please do not leave your gear in the hangar after hours. All gear must be packed and removed 30 minutes after the last load so please pack and then debrief.

Aircraft Operations

Our Aircraft will not wait for you. If you miss your flight, you will be charged your slot. Please be ready to board the tram well before the five minute call.

Off DZ Landings & Cutaways

There are lots of extremely good off DZ landing options. If you find yourself in a position that you need to land off DZ, please pick the safest option. Be respectful of the option that was provided to you by not damaging crops on your walk out to the nearest road. We will dispatch a vehicle to pick you up at the nearest road.

Please do not drive anywhere except the range roads (i.e. landing area, farm fields). In the event of injury, Edmonton Skydive has an emergency action plan in place and the Edmonton Skydive appointed members will take care of these concerns. Going outside of this protocol does not help and could endanger other people.

In the event of a cutaway, Edmonton Skydive staff or appointed personnel will assist in retrieving it. Again, please do not go out in fields to retrieve people or parachutes. Any motor vehicle driven off the range roads will be banned from the facility and event. Farmers will call the authorities and bill appropriately for the crop damage.



Facilities Rules

No Pets

Absolutely no dogs or any pets are allowed on the airport. Edmonton Skydive manages birds and other pests on the Airport through the use of two German Shepherd dogs that are not accommodating to other pets. Do not bring your pets anywhere on the DZ.

Security

The hangar will be locked 30 minutes after the last load lands. It is a secure building that is protected by two guard dogs. Unauthorized access will not be prohibited.

While extremely friendly and playful, the dogs are trained to protect their home. Please respect their space by avoiding wrestling, running or yelling in the hangar.

Camping

The Edmonton Skydive campground is currently at capacity. Please note that all fire pits are to be used at the approval of the Drop Zone owners.

Alternate camping is available at the Cannard Campground. It accepts RVs, motorhomes, trailers, and tents are welcome there. Please see the Accommodations section for more details on this and other local campgrounds.

** For those at the campgrounds please keep noise down after hours.*

Showers

There are limited showers on the DZ and the campground is at capacity. The showers get very busy between 7:30 - 9:00 AM. Plan your showers in the evenings or earlier morning.

Parking

Please park in the Edmonton Skydive parking lot or on the side of the road. There is no overnight parking at the DZ.

Waste Disposal

Please be environmentally friendly and respectful to the facility by putting garbage in the appropriate place. Furthermore, please limit garbage on the DZ. Westlock currently does not have a recycling facility.

Please use the recycle bins for plastic bottles, glass bottles and beverage cans. Please place all remaining garbage in the large garbage bins marked as garbage.
